Seeking: Jesus is on the move (1-4)

Questions to Ponder

Talk with Jesus about what comes up as you reflect together. Feel free to use whatever questions speak to you, leaving the ones that don't.

Did Luke's account of Jesus and Zacchaeus challenge my own expectations in any way?

What is it about Jesus that draws me in this morning? Where, like Zacchaeus with the crowd, do I notice resistance? Between me and others? Between me and Jesus?

In my calling to love God with all my heart, soul, mind, strength and to love my neighbor as myself:

Where do I find myself most ready and willing to meet with Jesus? Where am I less likely or willing to meet with Jesus?

Are there any areas of my "growth edge" where I sense Jesus waiting to meet with me?

What might help to support my growth process?

How do I hear Zacchaeus calling Jesus "Lord?" How do I hear Jesus calling Zacchaeus "a son of Abraham?" What difference do these words make for him? For me?

What have I noticed shifting in me during this Lenten season? What might a "today" response to God look like?
